# Cornwall County Council Healthy Under 5's A Fit and Fun Christmas:

Did you know that pre-school aged children should be physically active for at least 180 minutes (3 hours), spread throughout every day. This benefits not only their physical health and skills but also their cognitive thinking skills and personal, social and emotional development. Their behaviour often improves after a spell of physical activity and they experience increased feelings of wellbeing - something we all want! It's very easy for children to be sedentary at Christmas time so try to encourage your child to engage in some physical activity throughout the day. Whether it's a walk in the woods/beach, a visit to the play park, dancing to music at home, helping do chores at home and in the garden, scooting or cycling – there are so many ways to help keep them active. Try to fit in at least one of these each day.
