#### Portion sizes

It can be very difficult as a parent to know exactly how much your child should be eating - are they eating enough, should they be eating more? Healthy Under 5s have created some very useful information with regards to these queries, for children aged 9 months to 6 years. In a nutshell the ideal portion size are:



Fruit and veg: size of child's cupped

hand

Bread, rice, potatoes and pasta: size of child's clenched fist

Meat, fish, eggs, beans and other proteins: size of child's palm

Dairy and other alternatives: Hard cheese should be size of child's first 2 fingers

### Reverse Advent Box

Last year we used the idea of a 'reverse advent box' to support the children's understanding of the importance of giving to people who are less fortunate than ourselves. It worked really well and due to the support of all the pre-school families we were able to collect an amazing amount and array of Christmas food and children's presents for local families who are struggling. We are planning to do this again this year beginning on Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> December, the idea being that every day we add one more item to the 'reverse advent box'. However, we realise that Christmas is an expensive time of year for all of us, and we will also be asking for donations of things for our Christmas raffle, so if you can donate just a jar/packet of something then that would be great. A letter will be going out this and next week with details of the things the foodbank is requiring.

Fundraising update: We have had an amazing term of fundraising due to all of you and the community of Portreath's generosity. We raised £150 from Snuggledown, £200 from Bag2School and were presented with a cheque for £710 from The Basset in Portreath which was raised in their 'Come Dine with Us' evening. Wow! We are a very lucky pre-school!

We are intending to spend some of this money on creating Home Book Bags which will support the older Starfish, updating and extending some of our role play resources and purchasing some new wooden blocks. Rebekah recently attended a Maths Conference which focused on the current research around strategies and resources which impact future maths success - wooden blocks being a prime aspect! Rebekah will be holding a parent's workshop about the ideas and information shared in the conference in early Feb 2020.
